

League Registration – How to Register with East Grinstead CC Play-Cricket Web Site

It is a requirement of the ECB for EGCC senior players to be registered on the play-cricket web site, which enables them to be registered members for league cricket. (Parents of juniors members are encouraged to register them to help with team selection, availability etc.)

The initial basic registration data, name etc. is input by EGCC Administrator (Andy Hayes this information is taken out once you register with more detailed information) In order to view results and statistical information as it builds each week, also to gain access to record your availability for matches to assist with the selection of teams process, it is essential for those with internet access to register on the East Grinstead Club Site. This will just involve setting up your own user name and password, and completing your details.

Players, club supporters & family members alike can register in their own right to view statistical information, detailed results, etc, subject to the administrators approval, which will normally be given - it is a fairly simple process taking just a few minutes.

How to Register

1. Access internet
2. Search for **Play-cricket.com** and click on the 'result' which produces page <http://www.play-cricket.com/home/home.asp>
3. On the right hand side of the ECB 'Home' page there is a blue oblong box with the word **REGISTER!** Click on that box to reveal the sign in form to be completed.
4. Complete as much of the information as possible ensuring the compulsory fields marked * are all completed. You will need to apply a user name and password during the completion of these fields that you will use once registration is confirmed by one of our three main website administrators Geoff Border/Andy Hayes/Steve Pollard Please note: (The other optional information i.e. address contacts etc. will be extremely useful to the E. Grinstead Captains and other specific 'Administrators' and club officials with access)
(Warning! Make sure you tick the "No" field if you do not want to receive ECB information etc. otherwise it may default as "yes" when you exit with "save" at the end!)
5. When you reach the red box marked 'find your club' click on that button to reveal a search box starting with a dropdown use 'Sussex' then type in site name East Grinstead and " East Grinstead CC" will show with the word pick
6. You now click on " read terms and conditions" and " privacy statement" (click on accept " yes" buttons)
7. Finally click on "send form" (this will send a request to the East Grinstead site administrators for acceptance. Once that has been activated at our admin end, you will receive an automatically generated email advising of your registration and confirming your sign-on password that can be used in future to obtain 'member access' status. Once you have used the search left hand side ECB lead page and found 'club' 'Sussex' then East Grinstead you will obtain the East Grinstead Club site. Add this to your 'favourites' for convenience next time.
8. Contact Andy Hayes should you still require some help.
